AGE's South Facility

Thank you, St. David's Foundation! This naming opportunity will be afforded recognition via the entire AGE south campus, totaling 19,991 square feet. The campus will include all of AGE's comprehensive programming including a Thrive Social & Wellness Center, Memory Connections location, Caregiver U location, Health Equipment Lending Program, and a Caregiver Resource Center. In addition, this location will offer collaborative spaces, a co-working space, and offices available for rent so that other organizations can come together to jointly address the needs of the aging community. This naming placement has high visibility off IH-35 at 9400 Alice Mae Ln. Austin, TX 78748.

\$500,000 1/1 Available	Information & Resource Center This Information & Resource Center is THE safety net for the community when it comes to support and resources on caregiving for older adults and dementias. You will be providing a space of support, empowerment, and expertise.
\$250,000 1/1 Available	Health Equipment Lending Closet AGE's Health Equipment Lending Program provides free durable medical equipment and hygiene items for low income older adults in need. This closet will distribute thousands of items each year so that older adults can prevent potentially fatal falls, maintain hygiene to prevent illness, and remain safe in their homes. You would provide low income older adults with what they need to live safe, healthy lives.
\$250,000 1/1 Available	<u>Memory Connections Program Space</u> For the first time in AGE's history, a designated space in an AGE facility will house the Memory Connections program. This program provides crucial early memory loss care for older adults diagnosed with early stage dementia. You would be providing older adults and their caregivers with a safe space to participate in evidence informed care

designed to boost cognitive function, maintain healthy habits, and prepare them for their journey ahead.

You would empower caregivers with the tools they need to allow their loved ones to age in place longer, provide dignified and compassionate care, and ensure their own mental and physical health are maintained.

The AGE Computer Lab program began in 1998 and continues to connect the wisdom of seniors with the wonders of technology and the internet. This donation will enable and create a space for connectivity both on and offline.

\$50,000 1/1 Available	Front Garden Located directly in front of the entrance to the South Austin facility will be a small garden designed to create a warm, welcoming environment for all who come to AGE for care. This is a perfect opportunity to honor or remember a loved one as their name will be listed on a plaque installed in the garden, surrounded by beautiful flowers year round.
